The adult females are carrying cria by our own herdsires, mainly pure Accoyo, or bred by us. The males are home-bred from our foundation stock. Established and new breeders will all be aware of the significance of this opportunity.

CATALOGUE & ENTRY: The auction will be held at Blenheim Cottage in Oxfordshire on Thursday the 16th of April 2009 commencing 1.30pm. Entry to the sale, which will include morning coffee and a hog roast lunch with drinks, will be by catalogue - applications for which may be made by e-mail, phone or fax. Full details and pictures will be shown in the catalogue.

VIEWING: Viewing will be by appointment during 13th-15th April (including Easter Monday), and on sale day morning from 10.00am. The Auction, which will be conducted by Mr. Humphrey Butler, will start at 1.30pm. Telephone bidding will be available if required.
